

## Health & Safety Policy

## 2SB will:

- 1. control and mitigate the health & safety risks arising from work activities directly within our control.
- 2. provide training to employees to enable them to make competent decisions regarding their health & safety when working on client sites.
- 3. ensure that employees are empowered to put their safety & health first and foremost and have the confidence and understanding that the company supports them to stop working in any situation in which they assess there is potential to be exposed to unsafe working conditions.
- 4. regularly consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety.
- 5. provide information, instruction, training and supervision for employees.
- 6. promptly investigate accidents, incidents and near misses.
- 7. prevent injury and ill health by complying with applicable legal requirements, best practice and other requirements relating to occupational health and safety.
- 3. measure, monitor and revise our health and safety arrangements to continually improve health and safety within our organisation.
- 9. promote mental health awareness amongst all staff and site operatives.
- 10. review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals

The Senior Director has overall company responsibility for health & safety within 2SB. All employees are required to cooperate in preventing harm to themselves and others. We ensure that health & safety issues are considered as the highest business priority.
